Alvis Front Wheel Drive 1928 One of only 142 ever produced (a mere 36 are still in existence). These Front Wheel Drive cars were designed for the race by Alvis and carefully distributed to skilled drivers. This model was indeed very advanced technology for its period. -Front wheel drive -All round independant suspension -Permanent compressor -Overhead camshaft driven by gears -In-board brakes -Straight cut gears in 4 speed box These cars won their class in the 1928 24H of LE MANS and ended 6th general after much more powerful competitors. This particular car is fitted from original with pointed tail "Tourist Trophy" body by CARBODIES. It is in excellent all round condition with some lovely patina. Full history from day 1 known and only 38.000 miles since new! A rare opportunity to purchase a unique period race-car.
