Aston Martin V8 Manual 1978 LHD From this early Aston Martin V8 I very much like: - The typical seventies line. Pure design without the, in my opinion, ugly spoilers. - The lazy power of this mighty V8 engine. - The very rare (only 125 examples produced in this configuration) 5-speed manual gearbox. From this particular V8 Saloon I like: - The totally original very sound condition. - The fact that there were only 3 previous owners. - The low mileage (only 43,000 Miles) - The original very nicely aged paint in Orchard Green. - The original nicely patinated fawn leather with green piping interior (drivers seat cushion is in restoration). From her time in the hands of the previous owners, I like: - That the engine was completely overhauled only 6,000 miles ago. - That the last Swiss owner did spend 12.000 Euro to tune this Aston Martin to European specifications and through the severe Swiss MFK (Swiss annual technical inspection). I like all the points above but when I am seated in the drivers seat I especially like: - The relaxed driving if you are in the mood for it... but also: - The brisk performances readily available with this rare manual V8. Comes with Factory Car Record, proof of import into the EEC (all taxes paid), last Swiss registration documents, original Owners Handbook, Service Booklet, Complete service history when in the USA.
